Exciting Special Sessions at the Fire Congress

One of the more exciting aspects of the Fire Congresses are the special sessions. These sessions are organized by individuals who recruit experts to present talks centered on specific topics.

While the deadline for the submission of these does not close until September 1, we have already received many formal submissions!

The largest of these is a three-day symposium planned by the Joint Fire Science Program, in part as a look back at the changes resulting from ten years of fire science investment, and also as a look forward to the challenges and investments needed in the next five to ten years. Other sessions planned include:

- the National Fire and Fire Surrogate Study,
- carbon sequestration,
- plant traits influencing flammability and their role in ecological strategies,
- fuel classifications,
- monitoring fire effects,
- and patterns of fire history and climate change.
