

## **Assistant/Associate Professor of Forestry Tenure-Track**

New Mexico Highlands University is accepting applications for a Tenure-Track Assistant/Associate Professor of Forestry with expertise in wildland fire management starting August 2008. Teaching responsibilities include Fire Ecology, Project Fires and Rehabilitation, Prescribed Fire Laboratory, Landscape Ecology and Wildfires, and other courses as appropriate.

### **Duties and Responsibilities include:**

- Coordinate wildfire concentration
- Prepare and teach selected courses
- Advise and mentor students
- Fulfill service responsibilities to the department and university
- Develop a research program in wildland fire and fire management
- Other duties may be assigned

**Supervisory Responsibilities:** Graduate teaching assistants, work-study students.

**Minimum Qualifications:** PhD in Forestry or closely related field. Demonstrated experience in working with and research in wildland fire. A well qualified candidate who is close to completion of a terminal degree may be considered.

**Preferred Qualification:** Teaching and postdoctoral experience; successful grantsmanship; success working with diverse student populations; interest and/or experience implementing curricula; previous experience interacting with multicultural communities.
